The following questions and answers are made part of this Request for Proposals and are published herein to improve understanding of the scope of the services to be provided.

Question # 1: Can you Provide locations to the easements?

Answer: The Town does not have a list of scheduled work; this work is scheduled as needed.

Question # 2: Can you provide maps?

Question # 3: What is the size of the easements?

Answer: Varying sizes.

Question # 4: What pricing structure are you seeking?

Question # 5: Will the Town provide pick up debris services? Or is the contractor responsible for the debris?

Question # 6: Once the contractor is contacted for services, how much time does the contractor have to respond to the service call?
